MINUTES

FEBRUARY 25, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm at the Stony Ridge Branch Library by Board President, John Selzer.

SECRETARY'S MINUTES: David made and Mary Jo seconded a motion to approve the Secretary's minutes. All ayes recorded.

FISCAL OFFICER'S STATEMENTS: The monthly allocations were Gross \$37,224.68 minus Woodlink \$1,515.36 leaving a Net of \$35,709.32. Ariel has contacted Cintas for prices of cleaning supplies to compare them to Brown Supply, our present supplier. Tree removal and updated lighting at Stony Ridge have been completed. The paintings by Gerald Hill have been hung in the Community Room at Stony Ridge. Laura will look for information on the buildings depicted for descriptions to be placed next to the paintings. Ariel mentioned several kits received by the library that because of their size, cost and storage requirements make them difficult to display.
